
Getting from Dublin Airport

To the University of Exeter (Streatham Campus)





You will need to fly into either Exeter or Bristol Airport

Flying into Exeter Airport

There are limited flights from Dublin to Exeter Airport which will include at least one change over.

It is advisable to book a flight as early as possible.

Exeter airport is approximately 45 minutes from **Exeter campuses**

• Catch Bus 56 from outside the airport to Exeter St David's station and then find a taxi outside the station to take you to Streatham campus



It might take you longer than normal to get through any airport checks so make sure you leave **plenty of time** between connecting flights!

Flying into Bristol Airport

There are a couple of direct flights each day from Dublin to Bristol operated by different airlines. The journey time is 1 hour 5 minutes.

It is advisable to book a flight as early as possible.

Bristol airport is approximately 2 hours from Exeter campuses

• Catch the A2 bus (Airport Flyer Express) from outside the airport to Bristol Temple Meads and then the train to Exeter St David's train station.
